Gender-based violence

Gender-based violence, in all its forms, affects mostly women. It reflects and reinforces inequalities between women and men and remains a major problem in the European Union.

The European Parliament resolution on the elimination of violence against women (26 November 2009) and the Council of the EU's conclusions on the eradication of violence against women (8 March 2010) highlighted the lack of available and comparable data on violence against women in the European Union. The European Institute for Gender Equality carries out research on gender-based violence so that it can provide policy makers and experts with existing data, information and resources on the prevention of and combating gender-based violence.

The **Resources** cover various forms of genderbased violence, e.g. domestic violence, intimate partner violence; rape, sexual harassment and other forms of sexual abuse; stalking; female genital mutilation, forced marriage, honourbased violence; prostitution and trafficking.

More than 26,000 references, comprising policy documents, grey literature, online resources, books, articles, and databases are accessible via a search tool and are available in several languages including Dutch, English, French, German and Swedish.

It is the first time in European history that so many documents on gender-based violence are available through one portal, which is updated regularly.


